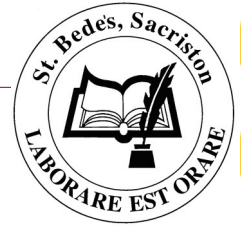


# Weekly Dates Letter

### Just a note
