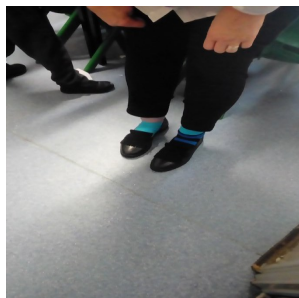
Anti-Bullying Week

The children also watched Trolls to remind them that we are all different but all equal.

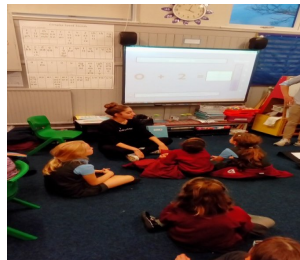


See if you can guess who these odd socks belong to!
