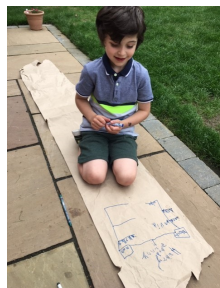

Jenny designed and created her own amazing birthday cake whilst Henry created his own family tree. Great work!



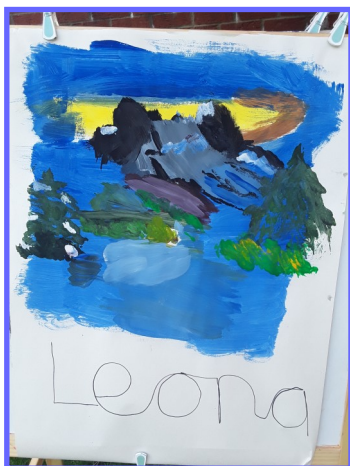
Harry and Lilly made a beautiful wind chime together. Well done!



What a fantastic garden picture, Santiago!

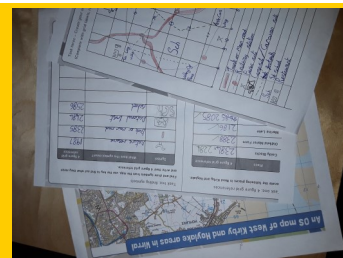


Zak has been helping to build a wall-what a great construction project and it looks brilliant!

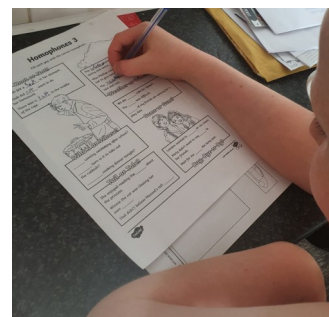


Leona painted a beautiful painting following instructions from the amazing Bob Ross! Look at those happy little clouds and trees!
