

Sacriston St. Bedes RC Primary School Sports Premium 2018-2019

Our sports premium allowance for 2017-18 is £16000 +£820 =£16820 (+ £10 per child Y1-6=82 x10=£820). We aim to use this funding to have a lasting impact on the health and fitness of our children, by promoting healthy lifestyles, improving the teaching of PE, providing opportunities to participate in a range of competitions, to offer a range of out of school clubs and create links with local sporting clubs.
