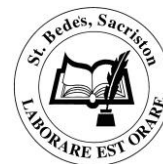

Parent Comments

There were no parent comments given in the Ofsted questionnaire.

However, we are always striving to improve our practice and are addressing the areas which a slightly higher percentage of parents disagreed with, which were how we deal with bullying and receiving appropriate homework (see above.)

Anti-Bullying

We have an anti-bullying policy in place which you can find on our website and have held a parent session this term in which parents were invited to hear how we deal with any incidents of bullying and also how to help their child. All classes also carried out anti-bullying work in PSHE this half term and as part of anti-bullying week. We use restorative approaches across school to resolve conflict, alongside our 'good to be green' system.

The Ofsted report from March 2019 states the following:

'In the online questionnaire, Parent View, a small number of parents indicated that the school does not deal effectively with bullying. The evidence gathered during the inspection does not support this view. Pupils have a good understanding of what bullying is and say that there are few incidents. When they do occur, these are dealt with appropriately. Very detailed school records confirm this.' The results of the question regarding bullying in the pupil questionnaire below also confirm this.

Homework

We are keen to ensure homework at St Bede's is purposeful and enjoyable. We have consulted with all stakeholders on homework this term and you will receive the results of the findings. A new homework policy has been written to ensure that our rationale is clear. If you have any questions about homework, please do not hesitate to ask your child's teacher.
